College Selected Activity

Purpose:

To outline who is required to complete the College Selected Activities to register with the College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba.

Definitions:

Jurisprudence-The study of the legislation (Act, Regulations, Bylaws) standards of practice and code of ethics that govern the practice of a regulated health profession.

College Selected Activity (CSA)- The term “College Selected Activity” was chosen to encompass the topics of jurisprudence, ethical decision making, and other topics based on professional and public interest issues.

The College Selected Activity is an activity:

- Approved by the Board of Assessors and Council, that may be in the form of education modules or other formats
- Based on the Standards of Practice/Practice Directions, Code of Ethics, or legislation relevant to physiotherapy practice
- Released to registrants with completion required prior to renewal
- Mandatory for renewal, conversion of license, or registering with the college for the first time

Policy:

Mandatory participation in the College Selected Activity provides each new registrant with education on the legislation (Act, Regulations, Bylaws), standards of practice, and code of ethics that govern the practice of Physiotherapy in Manitoba along with other topics known to be of relevance that impact the practice of Manitoba physiotherapists. Regularly planned participation ensures existing registrants are aware of their professional obligations of licensure.

1. All new applicants to the College, those renewing their Active registration, and those converting to Active registration must complete all required College Selected Activities before a certificate of practice/license is issued.
2. The College Selected Activities that are required will be determined by the Board of Assessors.
3. If an examination or quiz is present, pass marks for all College Selected Activities is 60%. New registrants and current practitioners must achieve the pass mark to be considered as completing the College Selected Activity.
